Students' progress in practicum is assessed each trimester in terms of a set of skills (described below) that the program considers necessary for the successful practice of family therapy. Demonstration of each of the skills is assessed on a five point scale. A "5" on an item means that the student consistently demonstrated the described behavior or skill. A "4" means that the student often demonstrated the described behavior or skill. A "2" means that the student seldom demonstrated the described behavior or skill. A "1" means that the student never demonstrated the described behavior or skill. The practicum grade is determined in the following way:

- A no more than five 4s; nothing below 4
- B more than five 4s and/or up to two 3s; nothing below 3
- C more than two 3s and/or up to two 2s; nothing below 2
- D more than two 2s and/or up to two 1s
- F more than two *I*s

Students must be able to consistently do the following:

 Be prompt in scheduling ongoing weekly meetings with supervisor
 Be punctual and attend regular scheduled weekly meeting
 Be receptive to feedback from faculty and colleagues (Open to need for personal growth as relevant to
development as a researcher)
 Actively participate in discussing relevant research and professional issues
 Maintain professional relationships with supervisor(s)
 Transition effectively from academic to professional context
 Gather necessary information for research project using computers, telephones, on-site visits and various method
 Demonstrate a systemic analysis and understanding of the research project variables at hand
 Identify what they wish to obtain from supervision
 Formulate data collection techniques relative to the particular project
 Write a comprehensive project report, which may include table charts, PowerPoint, benchmarking, and/or
governance policies, to name a few, by the end of the Internship
 Organize data and project information in a concise manner
 Submit all paperwork in a timely manner
Develop a reporting system to reflect the research project
